(d) to furnish and propagate by whatever means may be appropriate education and information to explain the history, culture, scientific and natural environmental values of the said area. and 3.1.2 to promote and encourage the preservation and improvement of the environment of Burntisland and its immediate surroundings and in furtherance thereof

(but without prejudice to the foregoing generality): (a) To monitor, comment upon and seek positively to influence town planning, architectural and environmental developments affecting the said area, taking into account the benefit of both inhabitants of the area, allowing for the growth in tourism. (b) to provide facilities, buildings, sculptures, monuments, land forms, meeting and lecture rooms, plaques, notice boards, benches and external furniture, signposts, paths, and the like to benefit the public environment of the said area.

It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts and seeks explanations from the Trustees concerning any such matters.

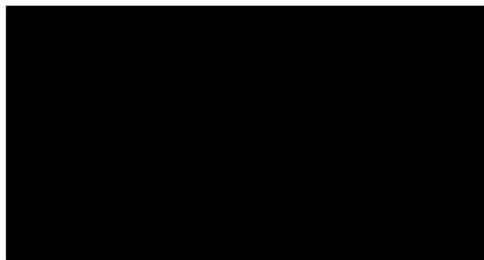
The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit.
