Activities: 'It carries out activities or services itself'

Purposes: 'the advancement of religion'

What the charity does: CCF provides Sunday morning services at 10am for all residents of Callander & surrounding area. A weekly prayer and separate Lifegroup meeting in addition to a bible study group takes place. These ministries strengthen and encourage people to grow in their knowledge of the Bible and trust in the Lord. There is a weekly 'Sunday school for children of all ages. Food and Fellowship services take place on a quarterly basis where everyone is welcome to join us on a Thursday evening. This ensures that we can feed and provide company for the lonely & isolated. The 'Love Callander' project provides local practical and financial support to the community. Informally, the church gives financially and practically to those we've identified in the community or through the local Primary School and financially and prayerfully supports Bushfire Ministries in Uganda our mission partners. Christmas & Easter missions are a means of reaching out to the whole community.
