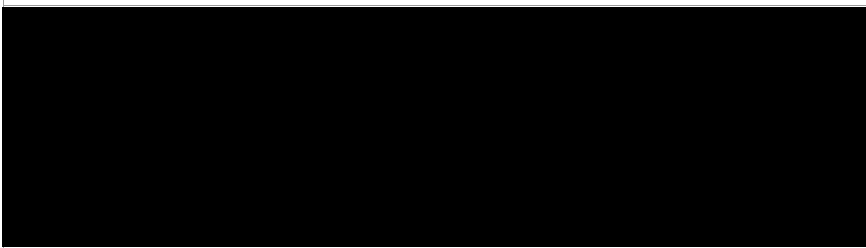

We are most grateful to the many organisations, businesses, and individuals who have helped us in so many ways. A grant from Unite was used to purchase a gazebo for events and open days.

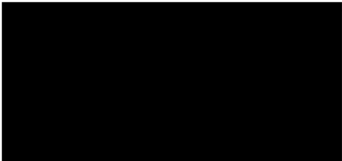
