Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

In March 2024, BOS applied to the Ian Findlay path fund for a grant to support the design of an active travel path that would link the local park and town centre to the canal, neighbouring area and sports centre via the local Golf course. The team at BOS actively drove the engagement and built support with stakeholders in EDC, the golf club, community and at Paths for all who were responsible for assessing applications for the IFPF.

After several months of campaigning and writing a business case, application and presenting to various stakeholders BOS were successful in this work and were awarded a grant of £30,000 from Paths for All under grant ref IFPFD2324009 - Bishopbriggs Park to the Forth and Clyde Canal Active Travel Route

Our group worked tremendously hard for this award but unfortunately it was very short lived as the members of the golf club objected to even the notion of a design for a path and the committee at the golf course withdraw support.

Significant effort, time and investment was made by our group, as well as stakeholders from Paths for All, EDC and other community members. We are all hugely disappointed that this opportunity has been rejected before it even had a chance to be defined or understood.

As of this time, no funds have been passed to Bishopbriggs Outdoor Spaces and the funds that would otherwise have been awarded are retained by Paths for All.

We will of course continue campaigning as a group to deliver better service and continue to explore options.



