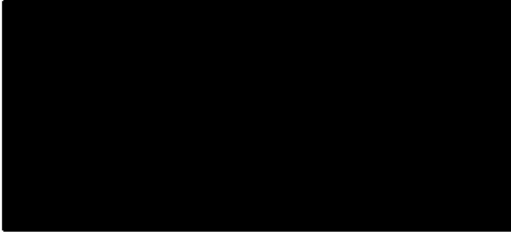

Administration

During the year under review the charity continued to carry out its responsibilities for the charitable operations, which had been transferred from the previous charity on 1st July 2023. Therefore, the comparative figures shown in the accompanying accounts represent a period of 9 months only.

Recruitment, appointment and resignation of Trustees.

In accordance with the Church Constitution the Trustees of the new SCIO charity had all been appointed on 20th. February 2023, albeit the operation of the new charity did not commence until 1st. July. Trustees are elected or re-elected for a term of 3 years in a Church Annual General Meeting and also serve as Deacons.

Governing document

A new Church Constitution exists, which states the purposes and administration details of the Church.

Charitable purposes

The aims of the church as set out in the Constitution, are the advancement of the Christian faith, primarily in Alva, and also throughout Scotland and the rest of the World, by all means consistent with the teachings of the Christian Bible, including but not limited to, worship, ministry, mission, prayer, witness, education, community service, and the support of agencies and individuals and other charitable organisations involved in Christian missionary work and the relief of poverty or other social needs.

Church-based and community activities

The administration and forms of worship of the previous charity have continued unchanged under the new SCIO, and the use of Zoom on a Sunday morning for anyone unable to attend in person has likewise continued. We were able to fulfil our Charitable Purposes by:

Church-based and community activities (Contd.):

Seeing the advancement of faith in the lives of individuals.

Either in person or virtually promoting worship and expounding the Word of God.

Continuing to supply financial support to other charitable organisations.

Hosting meetings of the Forth Valley Recovery Group – an organisation which offers mutual support to people with addiction issues.

Holding a weekly “Toast Club” to offer warm spaces to those with heating issues.

Holding a Thursday “Craft Group” to offer an additional resource to those in the surrounding area.

We continued throughout the year without a pastor, which afforded us the opportunity to enhance the building and facilities and effect necessary repairs, all with the aim of better achieving our objectives as a charitable organisation. The costs involved in this exercise are described as outreach costs.


Trustee Remuneration and Expenses.

During the period under consideration, the Church was without a pastor or any other employee. There are therefore no costs included in these accounts relating to pastoral or employee outgoings. None of the Trustees listed received any remuneration for services or expenses, except for the reimbursement of amounts expended in the furtherance of the activities of the charity.

Reserves

The absence of pastoral costs for the entire period had created a greater surplus than previously possible. Advantage was taken to continue and extend the process of carrying out repairs and renovations within the church. The Trustees regard the residual reserves of £72,890.62 at 31st March 2025 as being adequate for the foreseeable future.

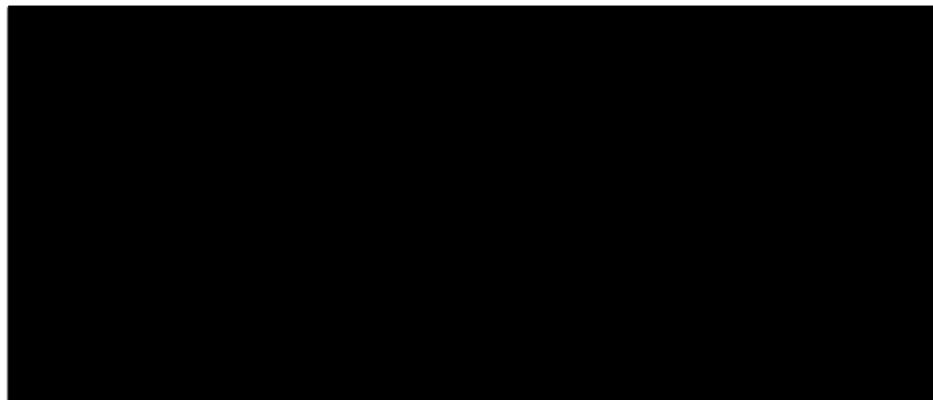
