For example, we would like to help youth people who struggle with downward slide behaviors by creating the space for dialogue, support and healthy activities. c) Showcasing healthier and greener ways of living. With community volunteering projects around ecological constructions, low-tech, permaculture, renewable energies, regenerative ideas for the earth and its residents (vegetal, human and animal). This allows us to advance the ecological consciousness of youth and adults in Glasgow. d) Curating Artists, Thinkers and Makers to collaborate with us among Art, Events and Workshops in a way to connect with our ecological movement and enlarge it. This helps promote Art whilst raising awareness about Ecology. e) Creating the space for Artists

and Ecologists to live on in order to fully practice their disciplines so that their experiences and growing knowledge could be a source of inspiration and education for our members and the public.
