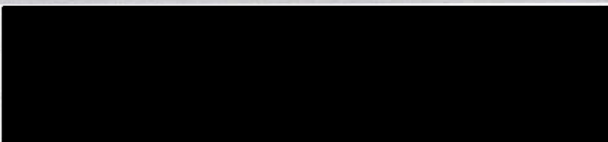

Direct support for Ukrainian refugees in Aberdeen.

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

1. Supported 70+ Ukrainian children at the Ukrainian School in Aberdeen

- a. Held regular classes on Sundays for pupils aged 4-15, without introducing fees for parents.
- b. Supported pupils in developing their skills in Ukrainian language and literature, history, maths, art, chess, taekwondo, dancing, and more.
- c. Recruited 18 volunteer teachers, who have undergone first aid training and obtained enhanced PVG certificates.
- d. Maintained good relationship with Rosemount Learning Centre who provide the building for the school.
- e. Obtained unrestricted funding to support the regular activities in the school (stationary, printing, food, etc).
- f. Organised special events at the School – eg the Christmas celebration for children with a theatre performance.
- g. Maintained volunteers staff to provide reception cover, reducing reliance on ACC staff.
- h. Kept Ukrainian mini-library operational.

2. Organised holiday clubs and activities for Ukrainian children in Aberdeen

- a. Organised Christmas concert and theatre performance in December 2024.
- b. Organised a trip to Crathes Castle for Easter Egg Hunt in April 2025.

3. Organised events for the Ukrainian community in Aberdeen.

- a. Organised Ukrainian poetry evening in March 2024.
- b. Organised peaceful demonstration on 20 January 2025 (1000 day of Invasion).
- c. Organised peaceful demonstration on 24 February 2025 (3 Years of Invasion).
- d. Organised peaceful demonstration on 24 August 2025 (Ukraine's Independence Day).

4. Organised and held a gala dinner Friends of Ukraine Aberdeen – with 50+ guests in attendance, including volunteers, third sector, Aberdeen City Council, Consul of Ukraine, Lord and Lady Provost of Aberdeen, as well as local politicians and industry leaders – to raise awareness of the Ukrainian community and Aberdeen, raise profile of the Hub and celebrate the work of the volunteers.

5. Maintained and improved communication through:

- a. Regularly updated our Facebook page.
- b. Maintained the website – ukrainianhubaberdeen.com
- c. Acted as a liaison between ACC and community members.
- d. Shared news and opportunities with the Ukrainian community.

6. Improved our organisation and fundraising:

- a. Received grants and donations to facilitate the work of the Hub.
- b. Improved our internal processes.
