The SCIO was set up by [REDACTED] on the request of the existing trustees and was recognised as a Scottish charity with effect from 18th Apr 2023.

The purpose of the charity is to provide foot healthcare services to those experiencing homelessness across Dundee and Angus

Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

The main activities of our SCIO is to provide and deliver footcare services for people who are experiencing homelessness. Our footcare practitioner and trustee Elaine Mckay. Elaine's services are all provided free of charge to people and provides this service in her own clinic and at the Eagles Wings Trust charity in Dundee.

Dundee Street Feet offers the following services:

- Routine care including toe cutting, and general foot hygiene.
- Signposting to emergency care where people need specific treatment for things like athletes' foot, bunions and infections.

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

- Continued to work in partnership with Eagles Wings Trust
- Received donations of footwear and new socks throughout the year for people who are homeless. This is a regular charity activity where people can give, and Dundee Street Feet can ensure they go to the people who need it the most.
- Regular foot care appointments throughout the year.
- Emergency foot care appointments where local agencies refer people to Dundee Street Feet to assess and provide basic routine footcare treatment. If necessary, Dundee Street Feet will refer to emergency services.
