Message from the Chair

The first year of Kirriemuir Community Repairs has not been particularly smooth. As you will be aware we lost a Trustee through ill health and another trustee has also had health issues. We have tried hard to find a replacement but to date have not been successful. This search continues.

In the past year we have received donations of £40.00 from the Gairie Inn, Kirriemuir who kindly agreed to host a coin collection from their regulars. We are very grateful for this donation however if we are to succeed in our aims we will need to attract additional funding.

Our biggest challenge to date has been attracting people prepared to serve as Trustees, we are aware that the minimum requirement is three and we currently only have two. If we cannot address this issue soon then future of the charity is bleak.

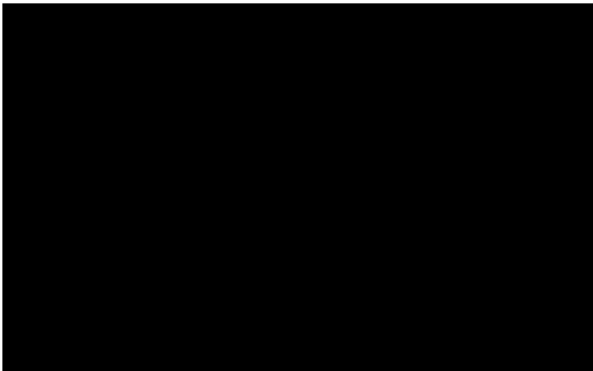
Looking ahead our challenges are to attract additional Trustees and to secure more funding.
