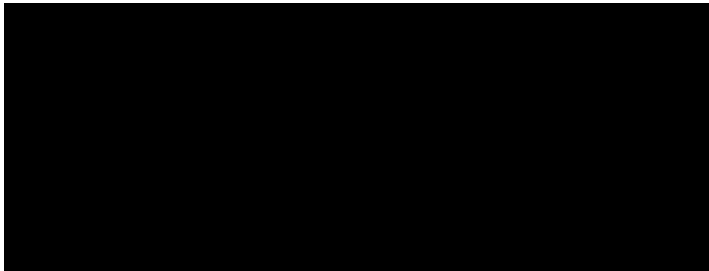

It was registered by the Scottish Charity Regulator on 26<sup>th</sup> June 2023. It has a single tier structure and as such the trustees are the members of the charity.

### **Objectives and Activities**

#### **Charitable purposes**
