Funds generated during the year were distributed to The Very Inclusive Play Club, which creates accessible and inclusive playgrounds for children with additional support needs; Down Syndrome Scotland, a charity dedicated to improving the quality of life for people with Down syndrome; and The Spartans FC, a local football club that was also engaged in charitable fundraising efforts.
