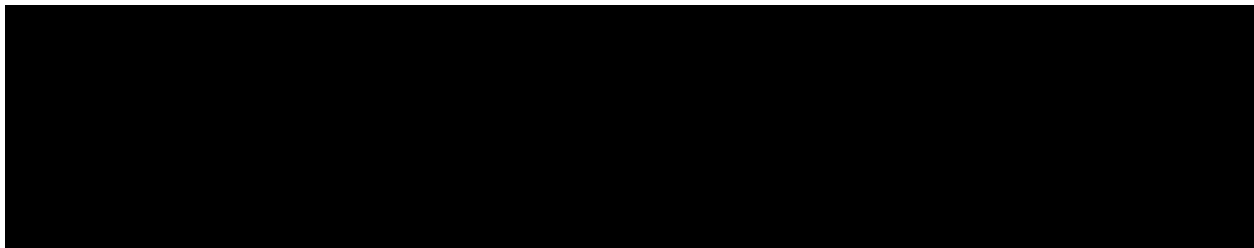
Achievements and Performance

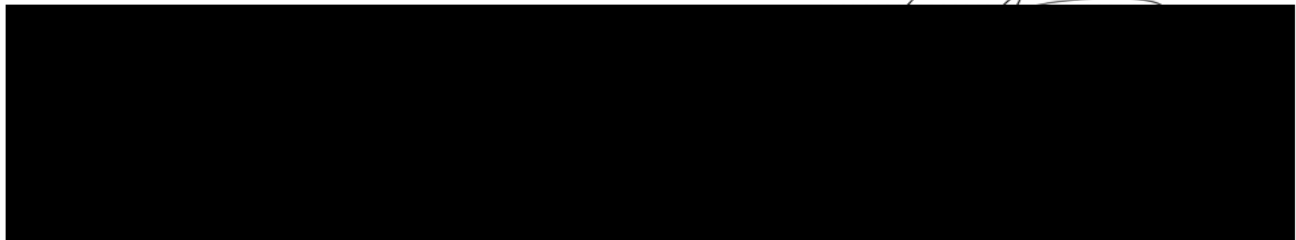
