The advancement of sustainable community development and rural regeneration, principally within the community of Duneaton, which comprises the villages of Abington, Coulter, Crawfordjohn, Lamington, Roberton, Wandel and Wiston and their surroundings included in the boundary of the Duneaton Community Council of South Lanarkshire ("the Community"), making it a better place to live, work and visit.

For the first year, we carried out a survey of the community to understand their ideas in order to create a Community Development Plan. This included a competition for primary school children to create a logo, community involvement in the design, then the survey was printed and distributed. It was also available electronically.
