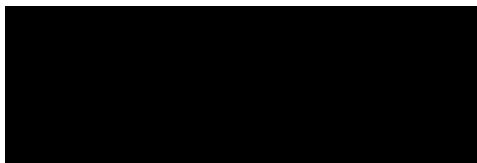

As a result, no receipts and payments account has been prepared for this period.


Plans for future periods
