What the charity does: Edinburgh Nightline operates a listening and information service for students in Edinburgh, which provides confidential, anonymous, non-judgemental, and non-directional support. We run a phone service and an instant messaging (IM) service, and while our service is directed towards students, our contact details are publicly available. Our aim is to operate our service every night during the term time of any of our affiliated institutions. We operate through both short shifts (8pm to 12am) and long shifts (8pm - 8am).

Objectives: The purposes of the charity are: the preservation and protection of good health among students experiencing or at risk of, depression, suicide, despair or distress, or any other form of mental illness at any institution of higher or further education in, near, or connected to, the City of Edinburgh, by the provision of listening and other services to support those in need. and to advance education for the public benefit in particular by promoting public understanding and awareness of mental illness among students.
