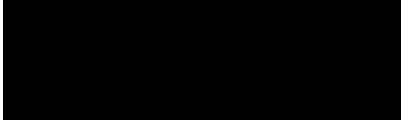

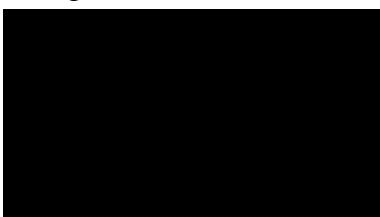

The organisation has not commenced operations therefore there is no income or expenditure to itemise. We have received no donations and have not completed any activities during this time.

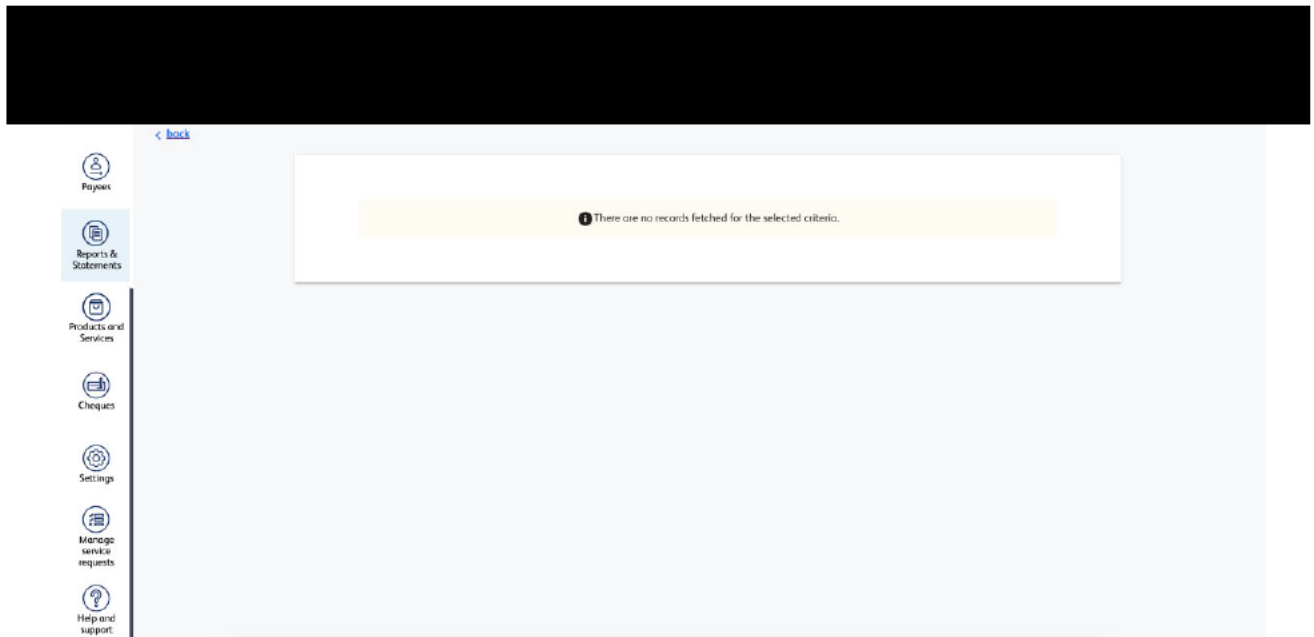
I am unable to produce a bank statement because there have not been any transactions in or out of our bank account. I have attached some screen shots showing zero balance and no statement(s) available.
