Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

Edinkillie Public Hall Trustees (SC009368) was been wound up as of 26/01/26. All assets have been transferred to Edinkillie Community Association SCIO (SC053934)

Edinkillie Committee Association is split between two groups, Community Association and Hall Committee as people wanted to join the community association but not be involved with the day to day running of the hall. The broader community association might become more relevant as Finnerne Community Council has been wound up and to ensure that the Edinkillie community continues to be represented.

Office bearer posts are difficult to fill, with the Treasurer continue to being acting Secretary, the number of committee members have also dropped. An Extra Ordinary General Meeting was held in July 2025.

The funding for the car park extension is ongoing, planning permission was granted in September 2025. The electricity pole has not received funds to move it, it is possible to continue with the extension with it in its current position. A Community Resilience group has been set up with regard to recent wildfires, it is essential to represent the local community in this regard.

Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

The main challenge to Edinkillie Community Association is with regard to rising electricity costs.

An application was made to Berry Burn Community Fund was successful to secure funds to ensure the future of the hall. This has been of great help to the finances of the hall, also Finnerne Development Trust has agreed to pay 60% of core costs from 2025 for 3 years.

Also, we were successful in getting funding from the National Lottery Community fund and Berry Burn Community Fund for the car park extension.

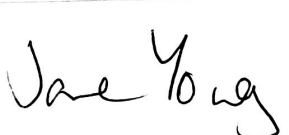
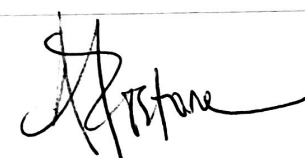
