(c) The advancement of religion To foster and support the practice and understanding of Christianity including religious education, and spiritual guidance. (d) The advancement of health To improve health outcomes through programs that promote physical and mental well-being, including health education and preventative care initiatives. (e) The saving of lives To contribute to the saving of lives through activities such as disaster relief efforts, first aid training, and public awareness campaigns on safety and risk prevention. (f) The advancement of citizenship or community development To enhance community cohesion and empowerment by promoting civic participation, providing resources for local development projects, supporting volunteerism, and fostering initiatives that address social inequalities and build stronger, more inclusive communities.
