(f) To reduce poverty, and enhance the quality of life for Black and minority communities in Scotland by promoting active citizenship and community empowerment. This will be delivered through targeted initiatives in digital inclusion, technology, cybersecurity, and addressing key social issues, while also advancing other charitable purposes as identified by the trustees. Those it will benefit Underrepresented communities, Black, BAME, communities across Scotland, particularly those who face social and economic disadvantages.
