The advancement of arts, culture, and heritage: To preserve and promote Igbo and Wawa cultural heritage in Scotland by organising cultural events, language classes, traditional dance lessons, and other activities that enhance cultural understanding and appreciation. The advancement of human rights, conflict resolution, and community safety: To raise awareness of legal rights, child protection, domestic abuse prevention, good parenting practices, and community relations, fostering a safer and more informed community for Enugu State citizens

living in Glasgow and beyond.
